Friends' Summer Fair

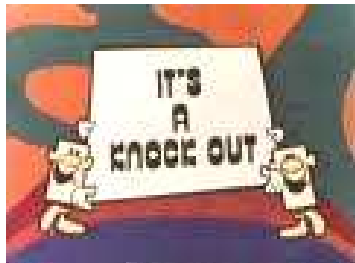
All Year 6 pupils wanting to run a stall at this event should come to see Mr Gatherer by morning break on Monday 21st June at the latest.
