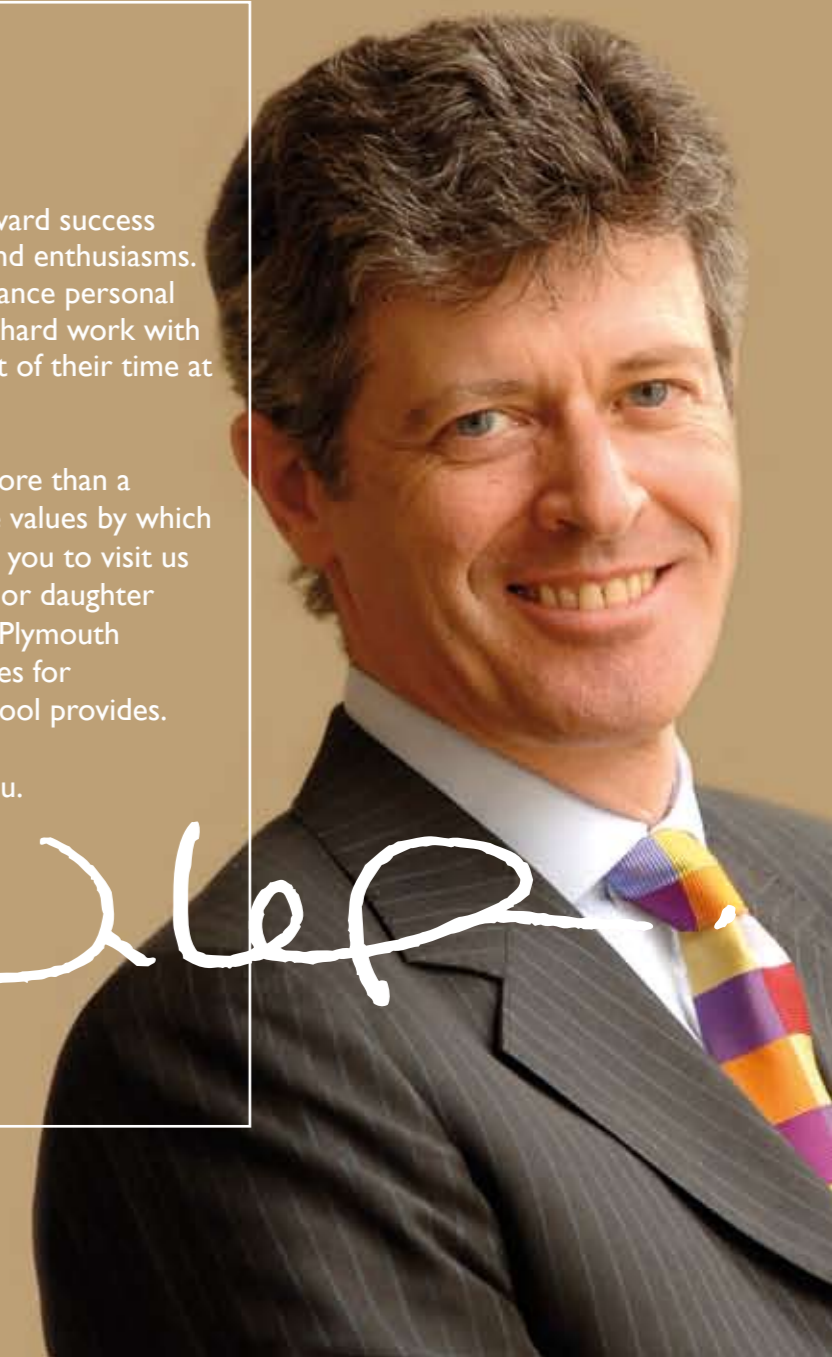

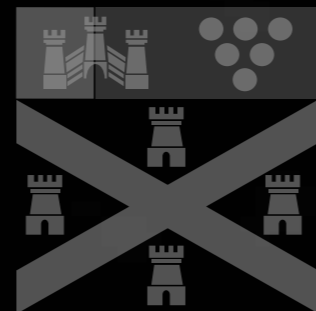


# vision

Founded in 1877, Plymouth College is a vibrant and busy school with a successful history.

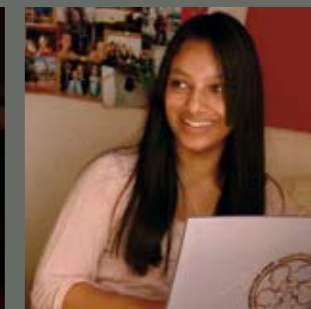


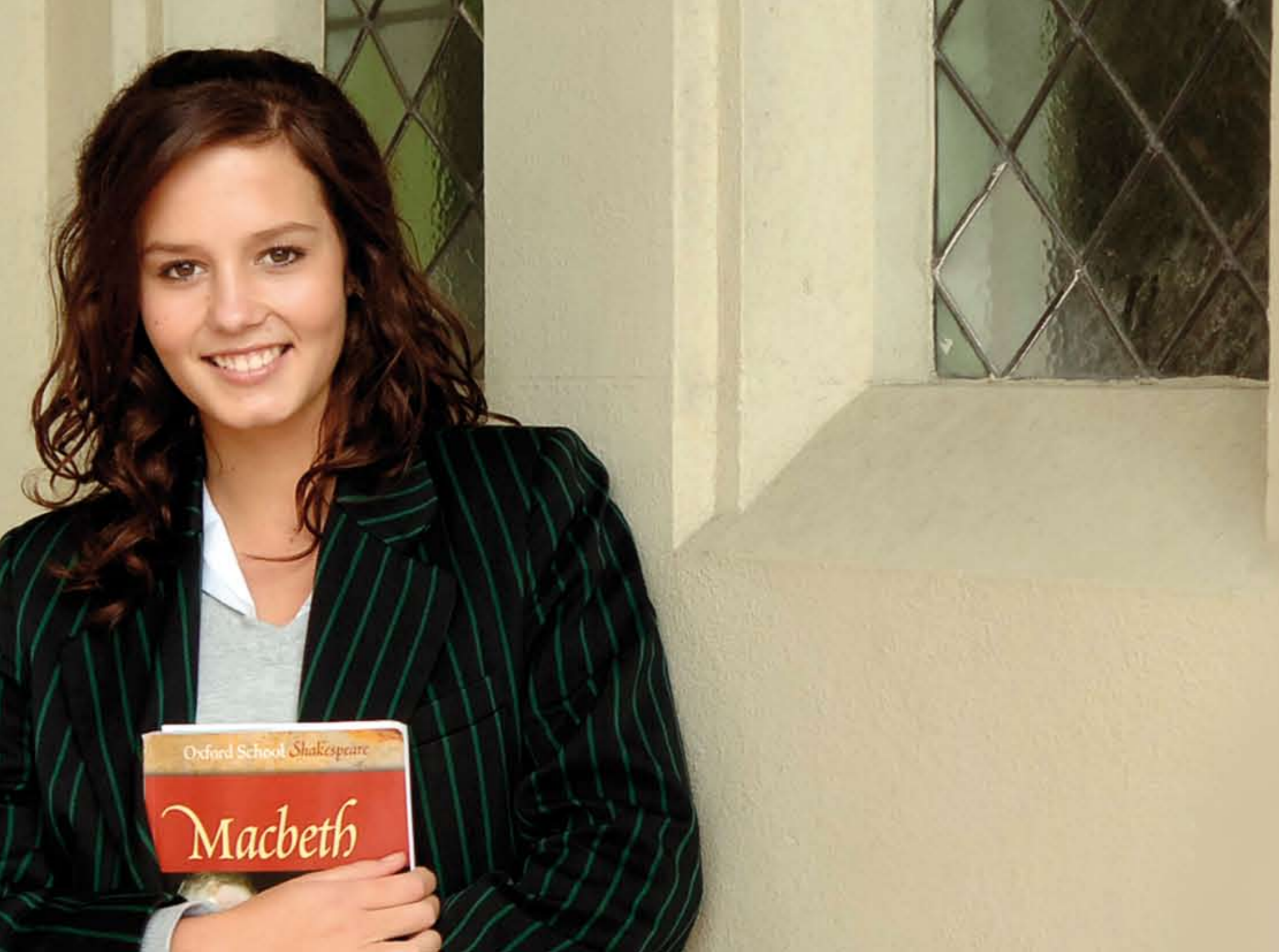
# happiness

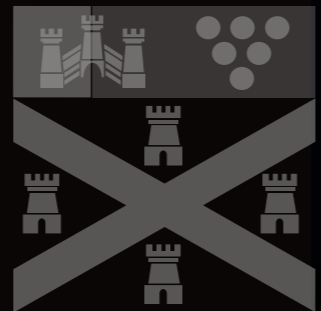


# opportunity

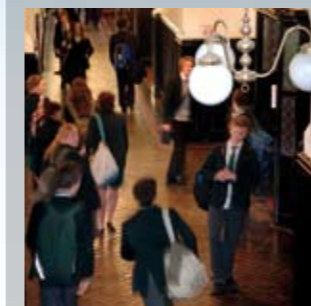


# community
