- (b) we, as holders of parental responsibility for the child named above, live together / separately³ at the address(es) shown below and we agree to notify the School immediately of any change of address or our family circumstances;
- (c) if applicable, we are not (either jointly or individually) in arrears on the payment of any fees or charges owing to our child's current (or previous) school or educational establishment;
- (d) unless otherwise notified to the School in writing before signing this Acceptance Form:
 - (i) there are no court orders in place in respect of the care or living arrangements of our child or the payment of fees for his/her education;
 - (ii) any information or circumstances about us and/or our child that has previously been notified to the School (including information about our child's health / medical conditions, disability and

² Parental responsibility is defined in the Children Act 1989 as "all the rights, duties, powers and responsibilities and authority which by law <u>a parent</u> of a child has in relation to the child and his or her property". It equates to legal responsibility for the child. The child's mother automatically has parental responsibility for her child from birth. A father usually has parental responsibility if he's either: (a) married to the child's mother; or (b) listed on the birth certificate (after a certain date, depending

- special educational needs as part of the School's registration and admissions process) is and remains complete and accurate; and
- (iii) our child has the right to enter, live and study in the United Kingdom and, if applicable, we have made appropriate arrangements for our child's visa application, travel, reception, living and care in the UK. If we require the School to sponsor our child and issue a Certificate of Acceptance of Studies (CAS) to our child so that they may apply for relevant permission to enter or stay in the UK as a student (for which the School may charge an administration fee), we have previously notified the School of this. Please note, if the School has made your child a conditional offer, then it will not be able to issue you with a CAS until the conditions of that offer have been met.
